High Commission of India in Kigali invites applications from experts/teachers to teach Yoga (Beginner/Intermediate) and Indian Classical Dance (Beginner/Intermediate) at the High Commission on part-time basis. A monthly honorarium would be paid to the experts/teachers. The posts would be on short-term contractual basis. In addition to regular classes at the High Commission, he/she shall contribute to outreach activities at other venues including performances, workshops, lecture-demonstrations etc.

Essential Qualifications for Yoga teacher / Indian Classical Dance teacher:

- Candidate should be a NRI with valid work permit or a Rwandan National.
- Fluency in English and Kinyarwanda languages
- Having a 3 years degree with minimum 3 years experience in teaching Yoga/Indian classical dance or a 2-year diploma/certificate or training in the concerned field for a minimum period of 2 years from renowned institution or Gurukul with 4 years of teaching experience in India/Rwanda.
- He/She should have adequate knowledge of history, philosophy and traditions of Indian music, dance, art and culture.

- Experience in conducting Yoga/Indian Classical Dance programmes, workshops and lecture demonstrations.
- Sound knowledge of using Computers and Social media
- Candidate must have good communication skills and must actively participate in all Yoga, Indian classical dance and cultural activities of the High Commission.
